The Brother's Keepers House is committed and dedicated to helping these men come out of the dark and into the light. Each man is responsible for his own food, paying his own program fees and keeping the house in a very clean and neat environment. Each client is in a different degree of their recovery, but yet they all come together as one making this one of Atlanta's Best Recovery Homes around. Each man is involved with the 12 -step process by attending weekly meetings. The house also includes High Speed cable internet and Cable TV, and washing utilities. So we try to make it as comfortable for these men as they make it as comfortable for these men as they make their way back into being productive members of society once again.
